Pinot’s Palette of Westlake Village provides the canvas, paint and brushes needed for each painting class. Guests must be at least 21 years old and can register online to attend two- to three-hour painting classes where they will recreate the featured painting of the night, guided by a local artist.

Public events are held in a roomy main studio that seats up to 54 guests. A private party room for 15 guests is also available for events. Pinot’s Palette of Westlake Village features a bar where guests can purchase wine and beer. Guests are welcome to bring in food, but are not allowed to bring in outside beverages.
